# Lyft's Purpose Is To Serve And Connect



**More than 44 million people** (8.6M in California) used the Lyft platform to find a driver, a bike, or a scooter



**More than 1 million drivers** (195K in California) earned almost \$9 billion on Lyft platform last year (not including tips), a new record



## Economic Impact

- 87% of riders say Lyft increases access to transportation
- 61% use Lyft when they are planning to drink alcohol or use another substance that could impair their driving ability
- 64% to get to or from entertainment and recreation

# Regulatory Compliance

- **Annual Reporting**
  - California trip requests
  - Completed trips
  - Lyft and other TNCs have filed Motions for Confidential Treatment to protect this sensitive data
- **SB 1376- Access For All Program**
  - Since 2019, Lyft offers "Wheelchair Mode" in Los Angeles and San Francisco Counties
  - 5,000-7,000 trips quarterly in Los Angeles County
  - 800-1,000 trips quarterly in San Francisco County
- **SB 1016 Clean Miles**
  - TNCs are required to achieve zero greenhouse gas emissions from their operations by 2030.
  - Lyft has provided EV bonuses totaling and estimated \$45 million to drivers
  - Lyft's electrification efforts are exceeding California's statewide EV adoption rate.
