

APPENDIX L

COMMISSIONERS ATTENDANCE AT PROCEEDING-RELATED HEARINGS AND WORKSHOPS

Public Utilities Code Section 910.1 requires the commission to annually submit a report to the Legislature on the days that commissioners presided over and attended hearings. AB 1532, effective October 1, 2025, revised these statutory requirements. Prior to its enactment, Commission attendance information was not maintained in the format specified. The figures presented reflect the requested information in the format now required under Public Utilities Code Section 910.1. For reporting on commissioner attendance at hearings, the report shall include reporting based on attendance at all types of hearings, including by all of the following:

- (1) Hearing type, including, but not limited to, prehearing conferences, evidentiary hearings, public participation hearings, and workshops.
- (2) Proceeding type, including quasi-legislative, an adjudication, a rate-setting, or a catastrophic wildfire proceeding.
- (3) Industry type, including electric, gas, water, telecommunications, or transportation.
